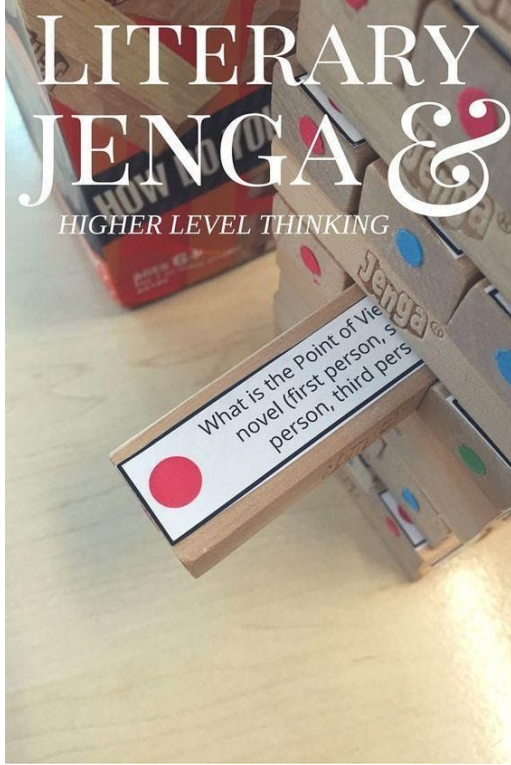


Literacy Games to Use at Home - see Tara Riggs (Tara.Riggs@gscs.org) for help getting the resources you need!



Use a familiar game such as Jenga to help promote literacy at home.



BOOM! Sight Word or Vocabulary Game. Words written on large wood craft sticks. Timed game. Kids pull a stick, if they read it correctly or give the correct definition, it goes into their pile, can't read it or give the correct definition, it goes back in. Pull a BOOM! Stick and your whole pile goes back in. Whoever has the most sticks in their pile at the end wins! Great for my kids who aren't flashcard kids!
